Certificate of Eligibility for Election to Board of Trustees of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund

Purpose: Ohio Senate Bill 133 effective September 15, 2004, made several changes to the Ohio Revised Code relative to the operation of the Ohio public pension funds, including a provision that a person who has been convicted of or pleads guilty to a felony, a theft offense as defined in section 2913.01 of the Revised Code, or a violation of section 102.02 (financial disclosure with Ohio Ethics Commission), 102.03 (restrictions on present or former public officials or employees), 102.04 (compensation or services received other than from agency with which person employed prohibited), 2921.02 (bribery), 2921.11 (perjury), 2921.13 (falsification; in theft offense; to purchase firearm), 2921.31 (obstructing official business), 2921.41 (theft in office; restitution; withholding of retirement benefits), 2921.42 (having an unlawful interest in a public contract), 2921.43 (soliciting or receiving improper compensation), or 2921.44 (dereliction of duty) of the Revised Code is ineligible for election as an employee or retiree member of the Board.

Certification: As a condition to the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund and its independent election administrator and/or the Office of the Secretary of State to consider the petitions filed by the candidate named below for purposes of running for election to the _____ Member of the Board of Trustees of the Ohio Police & Fire Pension Fund, the undersigned certifies to OP&F, the Election Administrator and the Ohio Secretary of State that the undersigned has not been convicted of or plead guilty to a felony, a theft offense as defined in section 2913.01 of the Revised Code, or a violation of section 102.02, 102.03, 102.04, 2921.02, 2921.11, 2921.13, 2921.31, 2921.41, 2921.42, 2921.43, or 2921.44 of the Revised Code.

Deadline: This certification must be completed, notarized, and received by OP&F no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 7, 2008.
