OFFICIAL NOMINATING PETITION

In addition to filing the required nominating petitions, all candidates must file a Certificate of Eligibility in the form approved by the Board of Trustees that confirms that the person is eligible to run for election to the Board of Trustees by not being disqualified for the reasons outlined in Section 742.046 of the Revised Code. The Certificate of Eligibility may be obtained at OP&F’s office on or after February 4, 2008. Candidates may have to file Campaign Expenditure Disclosures with the Ohio Secretary of State. More information on this requirement may be obtained from the Office of the Ohio Secretary of State, 180 East Broad Street, 16th Floor, Columbus, Ohio 43215, (614) 466-2585.
